AL IMAN COLLEGE

1. Rationale:

A uniform dress code reinforces in students a pride in their own appearance, instills recognition of themselves as an integral part of the college community, and assists in developing pride in representing their school.

The wearing of our school uniform plays an important role in instilling pride in the children and maintaining our school identity and spirit. This Uniform Policy clearly states our college expectations for parents and encourages students to consistently wear the correct uniform during school hours, while travelling to and from school and when students are engaged in school activities out of school hours.

Al Iman College uniform policy takes precedence over student's individual preference in matters of dress. In the establishment of this policy, issues such as the required quality of modesty in Islamic dress wear, health and safety and equality have been considered.

- Regular monitoring of student compliance with this policy is conducted by staff and continual reminders are made during assemblies, home-group, and classes.
- We at Al Iman College place the responsibility of student conformity to the proper uniform upon the shoulders of the parents/guardians. It is required of them that they obtain the current uniform for their enrolled child/children at Al Iman College from the uniform shop.

2. Guidelines for implementation and enforcement of the dress code:

- Parents and students will have a primary responsibility for ensuring that all students wear the uniform and that it is maintained in a clean and satisfactory condition. They will be fully supported by the staff in meeting this responsibility.
- It is the parents' responsibility to purchase the School uniform from the Uniform Shop.
- Sanctions will be applied by the College to those students out of uniform without a satisfactory explanation.
- Disciplinary measures used to enforce the uniform policy will be consistent with the College Code of Conduct.

3. Uniform Shop:

Al Iman College has outsourced the supply and management of the school uniform shop to a third-party supplier (details shown below); who has been entrusted with the task of running the uniform shop within the College premises.

4. Implementation:

- Students are expected to take pride in their appearance and grooming.
- Uniform will be worn during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when students are on school excursions or school related activities within or outside the school. This includes the prayer cap for the boys and the hijab for the girls.
- Sports uniforms are only to be worn on days in which students have sports lessons.
- Hair is to be kept clean and tidy.
- All students are required to wear grey socks only.
- No hats are to be worn inside the college building.
- During winter months, students may choose to wear a jacket or over pants for protection from the cold and rain when outdoors.
- In general, students may not be allowed to participate on excursions, or as a member of a sporting team, or in any school related activity within or outside the school unless they are in complete school uniform.
- It is advisable to have all uniform items clearly labelled with the student's name.
- If a student is temporarily unable to wear required school uniform, an explanatory note should be brought to the Vice Principal before school. Appropriate clothing, as close to uniform colours as possible, should be worn. The student will be issued with an out-of-uniform pass, which should be retained to show teachers on request.

- Parents/guardians of any student out of uniform without a written satisfactory explanation, may be contacted to bring in the proper school uniform or take the student home.
- If a student consistently gives an excuse that their uniform is in the wash, student may be asked to purchase additional uniform items.
- A letter will be sent home to parents of students being repeatedly out of uniform requesting parent support for compliance.
- Continued failure to comply with the Uniform Policy will result in the students facing consequences consistent with the College Code of Conduct, including the ultimate possibility of suspension from the college.
- Consistent failure to comply with the uniform policy will result in parents being asked to attend an interview with the Principal.
